- Abstract should not exceed 300 words and should contain within the border of the abstract form
- Abstract must be typed in **Times New Roman** font and of **size 12 point**
- The abstract should be organized along the following headings:

  - Authors: (Surname followed by initials only. Underline the name of presenter.

- Accepted abstracts will be notified by e-mail
- 3 prizes will be given to the best 3 presenters from each categories (1.e. Doctors and Paramedics)

- Marks will be given according to the following scheme:
  - o Abstract 50%
  - o Presentation 50%
    - Idea/Innovative
    - Design and Methods. Is it case series, descriptive, retrospective, case-control, prospective, or randomized control trial?
    - Is the design of the study answering the hypothesis/objectives/research question
    - Are the results presented appropriately? Does the result answer the research question?
    - Is the conclusion: appropriately drawn and relevant?
    - Language and presentation
- Each accepted abstract will be given 8 minutes for oral presentation and 2 minutes for question and answer. A power point presentation will be available (single projection only)
- The decision of the panel of judges is final and not subject to appeal
