Four Terengganu exco offices closed after Covid-19 cases found

KUALA TERENGGANU: Four Terengganu executive councillors' (exco) offices in Wisma Darul Iman here, are closed for 14 days from Sunday until Jan 30 after five positive Covid-19 cases were found in the building.

State Health Department director Dr Nor Azimi Yunus said the closures were to enable sanitation works to be carried out to curb the spread of the pandemic in the area.

The four offices which were closed were those of the state Local Government, Housing, Health and Environment Committee, state Human Development, Dakwah, and Information Committee, state Agriculture, Food Industries, Plantations, Commodities and Rural Development Committee and the state Syariah Implementation, Education and Higher Education Committee.

"The closures are necessary after five positive Covid-19 cases were discovered among the workers of the Prosperous Terengganu Human Capital Institute in Wisma Darul Iman recently," Nor Azimi said yesterday.

She said an investigation revealed that the infected persons identified were in close physical contact with the personnel at the offices of the four excos. - Bernama
